Key Messages

The following are the Key Messages from the Guelph Wellington OHT (GW OHT) Steering Committee meeting on April 27, 2022. They can be shared as appropriate with your staff, clinicians, boards, and partners.

- The GW OHT is one of 7 OHTs to be selected to proceed to the next stage of planning to be a ‘Leading Project for Home Care Modernization! Through this ‘Leading Project’, we are excited to advance our ‘Integrated Primary Care Team’ (IPCT) model which will see in-home care, care coordination and primary care all be delivered as part of a single team. “Leading Projects” will inform the provincial approach to transitioning home and community care services to Ontario Health Teams. The deadline for the detailed proposal has been extended to June 24, 2022.
- The GW OHT Steering Committee received and reviewed the work plan for 2022/23 as proposed by each working group. The planned activities of each working group are all in support of 2022-2025 Strategic Priorities. The Steering Committee will receive updates regarding the work plan as part of a standing agenda item where working groups will take turns highlighting the status, risks and opportunities of their respective activities. Each partner organization will be provided with a summary of their organization’s contributions across the GW OHT work plan. The needs of each partner organization to communicate the OHT work plan to their organization will also be supported.
